
Greetings in the name of our Wonderful Lord! Here we are in the last month of Summer. Where does the time go? Our

summer schedule of ministries is always varied. While during the rest of the year, we are holding revival and evangelistic meetings throughout the country and abroad, during the summer we are usually involved in many types of ministries. We began the summer ministering in Malawi, Africa with the Mobile Medical Mission Team run by the Euro-African Baptist Mission. We conducted eighteen clinics in three weeks. I had the opportunity to preach the Gospel to over three thousand people, and the joy of seeing hundreds come to Christ! Praise the Lord! Upon returning from Africa, we ministered in

a camp where I preached morning and evening. In addition to souls saved, we witnessed many life changing decisions made among the teens including a number who dedicated their lives to full time service. Since camp, we have held two

summer revival meetings in Iowa and Illinois, and conducted one regular children's VBS, and two of our signature Family

Vacation Bible Schools near Chicago. At one of these, the church folks brought over sixty first time visitors, and we saw a number of salvation decisions! Praise the Lord! Now that the summer is winding down, and schools are gearing up, we are returning to regular meetings. We are so thankful for all of you who support this ministry with prayer or financial support. You have had a part in each soul saved and each decision made!

We have completed our overseas evangelism for this year. It was our privilege to work with several missionary couples in Brazil in March, and with the Mobile Medical Missions Team in Malawi in June. We praise the Lord for the souls that came to Christ during these trips. We currently have two mission trips planned for 2018.

Fiji 2018



Paul and Martha Daku are veteran missionaries who have been laboring in the Fiji Islands for many years. They have four married sons. Three of them are also missionaries in the South Sea Islands. *(Two in Fiji)* The

fourth just graduated from Bible college and is still seeking the Lord's -direction. We have been to Fiji twice before. We were there for two weeks of ministry in 2009, and three weeks of ministry in 2015. During these trips, we have presented the gospel daily in different public schools. Some of these schools have had student bodies over one thousand. We have seen students, teachers, and headmasters saved! Each evening, we have preached evangelistic meetings in the local churches that the Dakus and their sons are pastoring. Again, we have seen many souls come to the Lord in these meetings. Next summer, the Dakus want us to come for four weeks. We have seen thousands saved on the past two trips, and are praying that next year's ministry in Fiji will be the most fruitful yet!

AUSTRALIA 2018

While in Fiji in 2015 we met a young pastor named Simeon Western, from Australia, who was just taking his first church. He invited us to come to Australia for meetings. We agreed to come in August of 2016. Bro. Western graciously volunteered to set up our meeting itinerary. We had the joy of ministering in five different churches in Southeast Australia and New South Wales. In August of 2018 we are once again headed "down under". This time we will be ministering in six churches in four and a half weeks. Once

again, Pastor Western has set up our itinerary. The Lord did some wonderful things the last time we were in Australia. We are looking forward to even greater things next August. Please pray with us that the Lord will raise up more individuals and churches that will stand with us in helping missionaries reach their fields for Christ. PRAYER UPDATE

We want to thank all of you who have been praying for Cheryl's mother, Lorraine Proper while she has been battling cancer. When we asked for prayer in our last



newsletter she had been through surgery to remove the cancer from her colon. The doctor also removed ten of the surrounding lymph nodes. Several of them contained cancer cells, so they prescribed eighteen more weeks of additional chemotherapy. She began those treatments on schedule, but after two weeks, she was unable to keep any food or drink down. She ended up back in the hospital again with an intestinal blockage, which was likely caused by the chemotherapy. She was in the hospital for over a week before the blockage was dissolved and she was released. At the appointment with her oncologist this week she was told that there will be no more chemotherapy for her. Please pray for continued healing. We know that even without the doctors, the Lord can keep the cancer from returning. Please join us in asking God to keep her clear from any additional cancer. Also, please pray that the Lord will give both Lorraine and Pastor Proper, encouragement and wisdom as they go forward. We appreciate your prayers!
