It seems hard to believe that we have already burned through the first month of the year! Where does the time



go? We were at our home base through most of the month of December. Normally

the weather there does not get really cold until the second or third week of January, after we have gone south for our first meetings of the year. However, this year the sub-freezing weather arrived in Maryland before New Years' Day and continued for over a week. For the first time in our ministry, we had to winterize our trailer water lines just to get to our meetings in SC because we had to drive eight or nine hours in below freezing temperatures with no heat in the trailer. We finally reached 33 degrees when we passed Charlotte, NC, and had to hurry to set up the trailer in the dark when we arrived before the temperatures fell below freezing again. The next weekend we were to head to northeast Mississippi. The day before we were supposed to travel, an ice storm went through that area of Mississippi, and the temperatures remained below freezing on the day we had to drive there, threatening our travel. Thankfully, the Lord brought the sun out and melted the ice along our route

allowing us to arrive at our destination on dry roads. On Tuesday of that week, a snow storm came through and



dumped three inches of snow, causing the cancellation of that night's service. Now I was raised in the North, and am used to driving on snowy roads, but when you are hauling everything you own in a forty-foot fifth wheel trailer, from one place to another, on untreated roads, it makes us happy to know there are folks like you who are praying for us, and a Gracious Lord who watches over us as we travel.
