Jn. 8:36 "If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed." July is the month that Americans celebrate their



independence. Freedom is a commodity that many people on earth do not enjoy. It is a principle that we cling to as an unalienable right given

to us by God. It has been said, "Freedom is **NOT** free!" Many have given their lives to preserve our liberty! Yet there is an even greater freedom to be possessed, enjoyed, and cherished. It is the freedom of the soul. It, too, was purchased at a terrible price. It cost God the death of His Son to make it available to us. Indeed, the Savior came to set us free:

1. FROM THE CAPTIVITY OF SIN. Heb. 2:14-15 "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil, and deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage." Our human parents plunged us into captivity to Satan and sin. **Rom. 5:12** "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" We are not sinners because we sin. We willingly sin because we were BORN sinners. Look at all the souls that are captive to things like alcohol, drugs, tobacco, pornography and more. Christ alone can set the sinner free from his captivity.

2. THE CURSE OF DEATH Jn. 11:25 "Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die." We do not have to fear death if we know the One who gives eternal life! Unlike the rich man of Luke 16, who when he died, was absent from his body and separated from God, the Scriptures affirm that, for the believer, **II Cor. 5:8** "We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord." **I Cor. 15:55** "O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?"

3. FROM THE CONDEMNATION OF HELL. Jn. 5:24 "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come

into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life."

Rom. 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus..." As our

nation has tried to be the ambassador of Liberty, and to take the good news of **FREEDOM** to the rest of the world, those of us set free through Christ should heed the words of the one who

liberated us: **Mk. 16:15** "...Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature."

OVERSEAS EVANGELISM

Fiji Islands Report

We want to thank those who prayed for us while we were in Fiji. It was one of our busiest trips ever, and certainly the most fruitful! What a harvest of souls we had! To God be the glory!

On May 31st Cheryl and I flew from San Francisco to Nadi (pronounced "Nandy") on the island of Viti Levu. Veteran missionaries Paul and Martha Daku met us at the airport at 5:30 AM, said "Hello!", briefed us on our schedule, and put us on a



domestic flight to the capitol city of Suva on the island's east side. There we had the opportunity to work with Brother Josepha, a Fijian who pastors the Victory Baptist Church there. It was his first time to have an

evangelist for meetings. He and his people were excited. For the first few nights we focused on revival. The altar was filled nightly with Christians making decisions. The last few nights were evangelistic. There were multiple salvation decisions each night. Everyone was thrilled to see the Lord drawing souls to Himself.

From Suva, we traveled almost four hours by car back to Nadi on the western side of the island. There we worked with Scott and Katie Daku and the newly planted Anchor Baptist Church. On Sunday we met at the school where the church usually meets, but on Monday we moved to the downtown civic center for five nights of evangelistic services. The Lord gave us tremendous meetings with several salvation decisions each night. Praise the Lord!



For our third week, we traveled a half hour north to the city of Lautoka where Paul and Martha Daku lead the Grace Bible Baptist Church. These evangelistic services ran from Sunday to Sunday. Aside from Sunday schools, there was not a service where we did not see souls



saved! In fact, on more than one night, the personal workers had to retrieve more chairs from the auditorium for personal work. We all rejoiced in the continuing harvest!

Following the Sunday AM service, we changed clothes, loaded the van, and drove two hours north to the town of Raki Raki for four nights of evangelistic meetings. Three years ago, we held meetings here that were the beginning of the Solid Rock Baptist Church. The church has property, but currently meets in a flat near downtown. *Please pray that God will provide the funds for a church building.* For our services the church rented a floor of a building near their flat. God gave us great services. There were visitors in every service and we saw many souls come to Christ!

In addition to holding nightly evangelistic meetings in each city, each day we went into the area schools to present the gospel using music, puppets, ventriloquism and preaching. We averaged two assemblies per day, with three on some days. Some schools had over nine hundred students. We did assemblies in both elementary and high schools. We had the joy of sharing the gospel with over 10,000 students, faculty and staff.



We saw a great harvest of souls with large numbers of students, many teachers, and even some principals saved! All the schools invited us to return at any time, and more than one school headmaster asked if

someone could come back each week to share the gospel.
