Greetings from western Wyoming! We have been so busy since we returned from Australia that September got by without a newsletter. The Lord gave us a tremendous second half to our ministry in Australia (**more later**). We returned from Australia on Thursday, September 6. Since we crossed the International Dateline, we arrived in the US before we left Australia! We had a



couple of days to unpack and reorganize before holding a day of meetings for Harvest Baptist Church, a

Filipino congregation in Daly City, CA. We had a great day of fellowship particularly since we have been to the Philippines four times over the years. For most of the following week, we rested and prepared to begin our Fall meeting schedule. We discovered after returning from Fiji in July that we needed to have a few days to rest after one of these trips. We go "full on" as the Aussies say when we are over-seas and it is hard to get much rest on the long flights back. Add to that the issue of jet lag, and it can take several days before body clock and energy get back to normal.

On Friday, September 14, we left the state of California and headed for meetings in the Salt Lake City, Utah area. It took two days to get there. On trips like this, we usually drive part of the way on the first day. We then pull into an RV park for the night and get up and finish the trip the second day.

Our first Fall meeting was a missions conference in a church we have had two revival meetings in before. We pulled into the RV park where the church has usually parked us since their church meets in a warehouse building. The last time we parked there, we had a fire in the roof of our trailer. We praise the Lord for how He met our needs at that time. We were thrilled when our stay at the park this year was uneventful. The missions conference went very well. During these conferences we emphasize both home and international missions and evangelism. During the week we preach on giving of our prayer, possessions and persons to the work of winning the lost! On one of the nights we trained the church folks in One



Verse Evangelism. This is a method that a pastor shared with us many years ago and we have used to great success. There were good decisions made during the conference, including some who indicated that the Lord had worked in their hearts regarding surrendering to full time service themselves. Praise the Lord! Our other two weeks of meetings bracketed Salt Lake City north and south about four hours apart. Souls were saved in both meetings and other decisions were made for Christ!

AUSTRALIA POSTGAME REPORT

In our last update, we gave you the “half time report” from our Australia trip. Now it is time for the “post game report.” The last half of our trip consisted of three half week meetings in three churches in New South Wales. The first of these meetings was at Victory Baptist Church in Mt. Pritchard, just west of Sydney.

The meetings were very well attended except for the last night when accidents on two of the major roads leading to the church snarled traffic and made it difficult for some folks to come. Despite the area traffic, we did have the joy of seeing souls come to Christ, and believers encouraged in the



Lord! Our second meeting was at Faith Baptist Church in Seven Hills, NSW, a suburb of Sydney. This church was an Arabic church with members coming from countries such as Lebanon and Syria. Three of the four services here required the messages to be preached with a translator. It was a week of good fellowship and unusual food! (*for us anyway*) We rejoiced to hear of souls saved even after the meetings were over. Praise the Lord! Our final meeting was at Crossroads Baptist Church in Rossmore, NSW. This church meets in a rented building west of Sydney. Again, we had the joy of seeing some wonderful professions of faith. It was a great week to end our ministry “Down Under.” Thanks again to each of you who support our overseas evangelism with prayer and funds. You have a part in each of the decisions made through our ministry.

LOOKING AHEAD

We continue to plan future mission trips as the Lord directs and provides. Right now we have the support for two overseas trips per year. For 2019 we have three slots open for these trips. In May we will be heading to Samoa in the South Pacific to work with three different churches on three different islands.



From mid June through mid August, we will be in the Canadian Maritime provinces. We also have the month of September open for a trip, but we have not settled the destination. We are in communication with missionaries to determine which can use us best at that time. We are also already working on plans to return to Fiji, Australia, the Philippines and Brazil. We are also exploring possibilities of ministry in Mauritius, as well as some other African countries. Please pray for wisdom as we seek to be where we can be best used and most effective.

UNUSUAL OPPORTUNITY

We had been considering a trip to the UK in January, but we have decided that we need to stay home for the month to get some much needed work done. We need to develop some new special music, release a newly digitized version of the Hal Webb Team’s “Unusual Songs and Stories” children’s CD, and possibly produce a new recording of our own music. It has been



almost ten years since we have released a new recording. We need to do some maintenance on our equipment as well. Due to this change we will not be booking any week meetings in January, but are open to booking the Sundays. If your church is within a three hour radius from our home base in western Maryland and you would be interested in having us come for a Sunday, please contact us now before all the dates are gone.
