Joshua 3:3&4 "And they commanded the people, saying, "When ye see the

ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure: come not near unto it, that ye may know the way by which ye must go: for ye have not passed this way heretofore." - **3.** The Lord will be with us. Josh. 3:7&10, Matt. 28:20 "...I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen."
- **4.** The Lord will provide for us. Josh. 3:5, Psa. 37: 25 "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread."
- **5.** The Lord will protect us. Josh. 3:10, Heb. 13:5&6 "...for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me."
- **6. The Lord will prosper us.** *Josh. 3:17, Psa. 1:3 "And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his*

fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper."

Understanding these truths, like the people of Israel, we should **RESOLVE** to:

- **1. Seek Fervently** Josh. 3:9, Matt. 6:33 "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness..."
- **2. Separate Faithfully** Josh. 3:5, II Cor. 6:17 "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you." and to:
- **3. Submissively Follow** Josh. 3:3, Matt. 16:24 "Then said Jesus unto his disciples, "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me."

evangelistic meetings in local churches, we also do public and Christian school assemblies and minister in Bible colleges.


If you are a missionary and would be interested in having us
