at Lystra and Iconium. Him would Paul have to go forth with him..." Acts 16:1-3 Timothy's mother had encouraged her son to godly life of ministry that made him well known in his community and caused Paul to want to take him as part of his evangelistic team. Canada West 2019



We are in the middle of the first week of our ministry here in British Columbia. On May 4th we left our trailer in northern Maine and flew via Newark, NJ and San Francisco, CA to Vancouver, BC. There

we rented an SUV big enough to handle our personal baggage and ministry equipment. We carry a portable chalk board, chalk, and paper for chalk art, the tablet computer that we use for playback of our chalk art sound tracks and duet accompaniments, and puppets to be used both by me in the services, and the kid's class she teaches while I am preaching.



One of our two carry-on suitcases is my Flugabone horn. We contacted the pastor we were scheduled to be with to let him know we had arrived and then drove to the Air BnB we engaged for this first week.

We appreciate each of you who not only pray for us, but also support us monthly for these international trips. Our first place of ministry is a small church plant with a missionary pastor. If we did not have your support, we could not serve churches like this since they could not afford the expense of our food, lodging, and transportation. This church also already rents a hall on Sundays so holding additional nightly evangelistic meetings requires the rental of another larger hall. Special thanks go to the Solid Rock Baptist Church in Corriganville, MD which gave a special

donation to cover the hall rental costs for this, and another church we will be with later this month that is in the same situation.

The other way we finance these trips is through the donation box on our display table in our U.S. meetings. Thanks to all those who

have given funds that way. We do this so we are not a burden to these small church plants. Please pray for our meetings here in western Canada. It can be a hard place to see a response to the gospel. Please pray that God will draw in folks who need to be saved. While the church members have been telling us how God has been blessing them and working in their hearts this week, we long to see lost souls come to Christ.



Canada East 2019

The day after we return from British Columbia, we will be driving into the beautiful Maritime provinces of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island, Canada for nine weeks. We will be ministering in eight churches and one Christian camp. We travel to the Maritimes about every three years and have seen many folks saved and many youths surrendered to God's call there. Please pray with us for a harvest of souls in eastern Canada this year!



ENGLAND & SCOTLAND 2019



We have purchased the tickets for our mission trip to the UK that we have scheduled for September. We will be working with four different missionaries there. We will be holding meetings in Peterborough and Manchester in England, and Loanhead and Livingston in Scotland. This will be our second mission trip to the UK. Please pray that the Lord will give us good crowds in the meetings, and that we will see believers strengthened and many souls saved.

MALAWI FLOOD RELIEF

We want to thank all of you who have donated to the Malawi Flood Relief project. In our last newsletter, we told you how the "Lower Shire" of Malawi suffered severe flooding. Many churches and homes of church members associated with our Mission incurred massive damage or destruction. Crops were flooded out causing a serious food crisis. Dr. Eric Chapman told me that over \$30,000 has been donated for this need, and that the Mission is currently involved in purchasing corn, the staple food crop of this stricken country, to distribute to these needy folks.
