## **FEAR NOT!**

*“Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer*

*and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.” Phil. 4:6-7* 365 times in His Word God tells us to “Fear not!” The spread of the Corona virus, the ensuing government restrictions, and their impact on our economy have caused uncertainty in many lives. Sensational media coverage has fanned that uncertainty into a general state of fear.

As I write, we are parked at our home church in Maryland. We have had three weeks of meetings cancel **so far**. But this is not our “first rodeo” with major uncertainty. When in January of 2006 I was diagnosed with bladder cancer we had to cancel meetings for surgeries and treatments, and scheduling became uncertain.

In the midst of upheaval, we learned to **LOOK TO THE LORD:** As **Philippians 4:6** instructs, we went to the throne of grace and cast our care upon our Lord.

*“Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.” I Peter 5:7*

Besides looking to the Lord, we learned to **LOCK DOWN THE MIND:** Isaiah 26:3 says, *“Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace,*



*whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.”*

Many spiritual battles are won or lost in the mind. Our adversary loves to introduce wrong thoughts there. When in 2006, he tried to bring morbid thoughts to my mind, I asked God to tell him that I was fully trusting the Lord and that he might as well not bother to put those thoughts in my mind since I was not going to go there! To God’s glory, I never had those thoughts again.

Finally, we need to **LIVE DAY BY DAY.** In **Matthew 6:34** the Master said, *“Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself.”* While returning from the doctor’s office after being told of more tumors, Cheryl asked what I thought. I responded, “We have followed the Lord one day at a time, one step at a time so far. He has provided

each other, our children, our “home”, and our ministry. He has given us everything we have ever needed and sometimes things we just wanted. Why should we **only** be willing to follow the Lord when He is leading through **good times**. Why should we not also be willing to follow Him when He is leading us through **difficult times**. We are going to keep following Him one day at a time, one step at a time.” I was diagnosed in January. By December, God had provided our needs, secured our thoughts, and eliminated the cancer! Praise His name! I know **HE IS ABLE! FEAR NOT!**
