
**Prov. 20:6&7** *“Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: but a faithful man who can find? The just man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him.”*

**Eph. 6:4** *“And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.”* Happy Father’s Day to all of you fathers and grandfathers! Last month we honored mothers and explained the ability that a godly mom has to influence their children and impact their world for Christ. This month, we honor fathers, the other half of the parental equation, as we examine the characteristics of a godly father.



**Barry's father**

A godly father **LOVES HIS FAMILY**. He works hard to PROVIDE for them. (**I Tim. 5:8 & Eph. 5**) He makes sure they have things like food, clothing, and a roof over their heads. He also PROTECTS his home, not only against physical attack or intrusion, but also from spiritual invasion and infiltration of the enemy through worldly TV, Music, the Internet and other sources. (**Psa. 101**) He also keeps a check on fleshly attitudes that can creep into the home.



**Cheryl's father**

A godly father **LIVES HIS FAITH**. (**Prov. 20:7, Psa. 101**) He does so PUBLICLY. He is careful to have a solid verbal and visible testimony for God in all his public dealings. He also does so

PRIVATELY. Those who know him at home, away from public view, can attest to his consistent walk with the Lord.

Finally, a godly father **LEADS HIS FAMILY**. (**Eph. 6:4, Josh. 24:15**) He leads them TO CHRIST. He is concerned that all his family is saved. He uses his relationship with his family members to bring each of them into a personal relationship with Christ. He teaches them to have daily personal devotions. He leads his children to a dependence on the Lord. A godly father also leads

his family TO CHURCH. He wants them under the admonition of the Lord. He takes his position as the high priest of his home very seriously! He not only leads his family in family worship, but he also leads them to a Bible believing church and gets them under the faithful teaching of the Word of God. Lastly, a godly father leads his family TO CONSECRATION. He teaches his family by exhortation and example to develop their God-given talents, dedicate them to the Lord, and use them in service through the local church. (**I Cor. 15:58**) There is a great need today for godly fathers in our churches, country and culture; fathers whose children will be “blessed” after them.” Cheryl and I are grateful to God for blessing us both with a heritage of godly fathers!

## Canada West 2019



### BRITISH COLUMBIA

We have just finished five weeks of ministry in British Columbia. We flew into Vancouver on May 4<sup>th</sup>. Our first meetings were with a small church plant in

Coquitlam, on the north side of Vancouver. We rented a hall for the week and set up and took down our equipment nightly. The meetings were advertised, but there were few visitors. However, we thank God for the decisions made among the believers.

From Coquitlam, we took a ferry to Vancouver Island. There we ministered at Grace Baptist Church in Courtenay. This church has its own building. We held meetings here in 2005. The church members were faithful, and there were visitors in attendance. God gave us great meetings with multiple souls saved.

We returned to the mainland and drove four and a half hours northeast to the town of Kelowna, located on a beautiful lake. We were only here for a Sunday to minister at the Peoples Baptist Church, which meets in a rented hall. We enjoyed the fellowship with the church folks, who said they were blessed by our ministry.

On Monday morning we drove two and a half hours northwest through beautiful scenery to the city of Kamloops. We were there to participate in a three-day pastor's conference. The conference began on Monday evening with a session that included two speakers. It continued Tuesday and Wednesday with morning, afternoon, and evening sessions. There were two speakers for each of these as well. In addition to the preaching, and congregational singing there was special music, including some from us. Besides preaching for one of the evening sessions we did a chalk drawing in the Tuesday evening service, and a puppet presentation in the Wednesday evening service. We were also asked to do an afternoon program for the youth on Wednesday while two seminar sessions went on upstairs in the auditorium.

Following the pastor's conference, we drove seven and a half hours east through gorgeous mountains to the western side of the Canadian Rockies. We held a week of evangelistic meetings for the Rocky Mountain Baptist Church, a new church in the town of Cranbrook. We rented a hall for the meetings. The church did a good job of advertising and there were some visitors at the services. Some came almost every night. We praise the Lord for


decisions for salvation and for discipleship in the meetings. We heard later from the pastor that some of the visitors who came to the special meetings, attended the church the following Sunday!

For our last week of meetings, we drove ten-hours back through the mountains to the city of Abbotsford, just east of Vancouver. We held meetings at the Central Valley Baptist Church. We were also here in 2005. The attendance was good all week and there were several visitors. We had the joy of seeing a young woman saved on the first night. Many church folks told us how the Lord had spoken to their hearts during the meetings.

We praise God for the chance to minister in BC and rejoice in those who were saved. We pray we left the churches stronger and the members with a greater desire to serve Christ and reach souls. Thanks to you who gave so that we could go and prayed for us while we were there. You had a part in each decision!
