They kindly offered to let us use their home and vehicle while we were there. What a blessing to have a peaceful place to recover. Second blessing: Trailer repair. We asked you to pray that the Lord would help us find someone who could fix the right rear corner of our trailer which was starting to separate. We were also praying that the work could be done on site while we were back East so we would not have to deal with it when we returned to Texas. God led us to a Christian couple who run an RV repair facility in Killeen, where the trailer was. They kindly sent their techs out, and had the trailer repaired in no time at a reasonable price. Third blessing: Safety in travel. It took two days to get from Texas to Arizona. We had to pass through New Mexico on the way. Interstate 10 there is one long wind tunnel with high winds and warnings about dust storms that can make



visibility difficult. The last time we drove that route the winds were so strong that they blew heavy semi trucks around on

the road in front of us. It also damaged one of the slide out awnings on our trailer. Once again we were facing that route. We prayed the night before that the Lord would reduce the winds so that we could make the trip safely. Cheryl rose first in the morning. It was still dark outside but I could hear the winds howling and feel them buffeting the trailer. Again I asked the Lord for the winds to be abated. As I lay there waiting for my turn in the shower, I started to hear the Master of ocean, earth, and sky begin His work. I could hear the winds subsiding and could feel the trailer rocking cease. The day dawned sunny with no boisterous wind. There was just a light breeze when we stopped to refuel and then continued on. As we turned off the interstate and headed north to our daughter's house in Fort Thomas, we were thankful that the same Lord who brought a "great calm" upon the Sea of Galilee, still answers the prayers of his children,

and brings peace along their journey today! Bless His name!! Fourth blessing: Healing and Strength. It has now been five weeks since the ablation procedure. I have had no more heart arrhythmias whatsoever, and am back to the full activities of ministry. Praise God!
